Shorten your path to a college degree! Take advantage of the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) at UVI!

Students can earn college credit at UVI for CLEP scores at or above the level recommended by the College Board.

CLEP will be administered on the following dates in the Spring 2008 semester on the St. Thomas campus.

Register at Access and Enrollment Services, Registrar's Office, in the Administration and Conference Center (Suite 120), first floor.

Testing begins **promptly at 9:30 a.m.** on each test date, in the Campus Advising and Tutorial Services (CATS) computer lab, CA Building Room 123. Latecomers will not be allowed to take the test. **Walk-in candidates can test only on a space-available basis and must present two (2) forms of valid ID, proof of administrative fee payment, and acceptable form(s) of test payment.**

The cost associated with CLEP is \$65.00 (payable to College Board) **per test** and an additional administrative fee of \$10.00 (payable to UVI). Credit card is the preferred method of payment, but checks and money orders are acceptable, as well. Cash will not be accepted.
