Application Deadline Date: March 1, 2017

Graduating seniors at local high schools who intend to pursue degree studies at the University of the Virgin Islands for the 2017-2018 academic year are invited to submit the scholarship application by the deadline date.

To be considered a student must:

1. Complete the University's scholarship application
2. Have applied for Admissions to the University
3. Have SAT/ACT scores of:
SAT- A minimum of 520 on the Math and 560 on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section is required for 4-year scholarship consideration / ACT-A minimum of 20 on the Math and 21 on the English is required for 4-year scholarship consideration.
4. Be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident
5. Submit one letter of recommendation

Scholarship Description:

- One-year Scholarship awards up to \$5,000.
- Four-year Scholarships provide assistance for tuition and fees; room and board; and books.
