## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES UNIVERSITY OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

Purpose: To approve undergraduate and graduate tuition rates effective fall 2013 for St. Kitts and Nevis students under the terms of a Memorandum of Understanding.

**WHEREAS**, UVI is com mitted to supporting the intellectual and professional development of the workforce in the Virgin Islands and wider Caribbean as part of the University's mission; and

WHEREAS, UVI and the Government of St. Kitts and Nevis (GSKN), acting also for the Clarence Fitzroy Bryant College (C FBC) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which would establish areas of functional cooperation and the tuition rates to be charged to the undergraduate and graduate students from St. Kitts and Nevis including those graduating from CFBC as per the terms of the MOU; and

**WHEREAS,** UVI is desirous of establishing parameters of functional cooperation and tuition rates for the MOU that would be directly tied to future increases in the University's tuition rates; and

**WHEREAS,** GSKN is committed to providing twenty-five (25) scholarships and or financial assistance of not less than USD\$7,500.00 annually and six (6) study leave scholarships at four fifths of annual salary annually, with a view to granting an additional five (5) study leave scholarships in the next three to *five* years, to St. Kitts and Nevis students to pursue undergraduate and graduate programs respectively at UVI; and

**WHEREAS,** on J u ne 14, 2013 the Finance Committee of the Board of Trustees voted to recommend to the Board of Trustees the approval of the basis for the tuition rates.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY AS FOLLOWS:

1. Under the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding with the Government of St. Kitts and Nevis, undergraduate students will be charged a tuition rate equivalent to 1.75 times that of the undergraduate resident rate of \$133.00, or \$232.75 per credit, and graduate students will be charged a tuition rate equivalent to 1.75 times of the graduate resident rate of \$330.00, or \$577.50 per credit, effective fall 2013.

- 2 Future increases in the tuition rates charged to students from St. Kitts and Nevis will be directly tied to the tuition rates charged by the University of the Virgin Islands.
- 3. The President and Vice President for Administration and Finance are hereby authorized to take the necessary action to implement this resolution.
- 4. This resolution shall become effective June 15, 2013.

## DRAFT MEMORA DUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) Between UNIVERSITY OF THE VIRGIN ISLAN S (UVI), GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATION OF ST. CHRISTOPHER AND NEVIS (GSKN) and CLARENCE FITZROY BRYANT COLLEGE (CFBC)

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTAN NG made this day of , 2013, by and between the GOVERNMENT OF THE FE ERATION OF ST. CHRISTOPHER AND NEVIS, of Basseterre, St. Kitts (hereinafter "GSKW), the CLAR NCE FITZROY BYRANT COLLEGE, of Basseterre, St Kitts, an inst rumentality of the Government o St. Christopher and Nevis (hereinafter "CFBC"), and the UNIVERSITY OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS, 0.2 J ohn Brewers Bay, St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Isl;;inds 00802, an instrumentality of the Gover, ent of the United States Virgin Islands (hereinafter "UVI").

WHEREAS, UVI is committed to suppor J. ng the intellectual and professional development of the workforce in the Virgin Islands and wid r Caribbean as part of the University's mission; and

WHEREAS, UVI, GSKN, and CFBC have a reed to enter into a MOU which would establish areas of functional cooperation and the tuition r, tes to be charged to the undergraduate and graduate students from St. Kitts and Nevis includ 'ng those graduating from CFBC as per the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, UVI is desirous of establishig parameters of functional cooperation and tuition rates for the MOU that would be directly tied of ture increases in the University's tuition rates; and

WHEREAS, GSKN is committed to providing twenty-five (25) scholarships and/or financial assistance of not less than USD\$7,SOO.0 annually and six (6) study leave scholarships at four fifths of an nual salary an nually, with a view to granting an additional five (5) study leave scholarships in the next three to five years, to St. Kitts and Nevis students to pursue undergraduate and graduate programs respectively at UVJ; and

WHEREAS, GSKN, CFBC, and UVI are co. mitted to the terms of the MOU:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED A FOLLOWS:

UVI and CFBC shall delineate a clear pa h of transition and/or credit transfer from CFBC to UV1 in cluding 2+2 and 2+3 programs.

GSKN through the Ministry and Departl1ent of Ed ucation shall commit to offering twenty-five (25) scholarships and/or financial assistanc of not less than USD\$7,500.00 ann ually to St. Kitts and Nev1s students to attend UVI as of fall s mester 2013. In return, UVI shall offer St. Kins and Nevis students pursuing undergrad uate and raduate degrees at UVI a tuition rate of 1.75 times that of the resident rate that is currently paid .y Virgin Islands (US) students.

St. Kitts and Nevis stUdents who are no recipients of scholarships and/or financial assistance, and who graduate from CFBC with an assocJ ate degree or equivalent CXC CAPE qualifications shall be offered a tuition rate of 1.75 times that /bf the resident rate to pursue an undergraduate degree at UVT.

Non-St. Kitts and Nevis students who gr duate from CFBC with an associate degree or equivalent CXC CAPE qualifications shall be offered 'a tuition rate of 1.75 times that of the resident rate to pursue an undergraduate degree at uv1.1

GSKN through the Human Resources Di 'ision in the Prime Minister's Office shall commit to offering six (6) study leave scholarships every y ar in the first instance with a view to granting an additional five (5) study leave scholarships in the ext three to five years, for persons in the civil service to pursue undergraduate and graduate de rees at UVI.

GSKN and CFBC shall commit to providi g dedicated classroom and office spee for UVI to establish a physical presence in St. Kitts and Nevi for purposes of offering applicable cohort driven undergraduate and graduate degree pr 'grams for those persons who for various reasons are unable to attend classes on the UVJ USV campuses. In return. UVI shall offer St. Kitts and Nevis students and non-St\_ Kitts and Nevis st ents graduating from CFBC and pursuing a degree under this model a tuition rate of 1.75 times t at of the resident rates for undergraduate and graduate students. Students pursuing a graduate egree should be admitted to the specified graduate degree program at UVI.

Prior to their attending or participating in any programs and courses offered by UVL UVI shall assist students in the planning stages to affor, the best opportunity to pursue those degrees and programs offered at UVI; and will advi them on programs and courses available at CFBC which will give them the best preparation.

UVI shall provide professional develop , ent and consultancy services to the Government and people of the Federation of St. Kitts an (Nevis at agreed u pon costs through its centers and institutes.

UVI and CFBC shall collaborate on projects and information/knowledge transfer in areas such *as* but not limited to alternative energy, e trepreneurship, conservation and fisheries, agricultural research, educational and psychological research pertaining to social issues, risk management, disaster maMgement, faculty and student exchange, institutional and student learning outcomes assessment, accreditation standards, in erinstitutional lecture series, performing arts, and sports.

GSKN shall provide the requisite exem tions to UVI faculty and staff to teach courses, perform consultancies, and conduct joint resear h with CFBC faculty and staff.

This MOU shall be for a period of ten (lb) years from the date of signing\_ A mid term review shall be conducted after five years to determin what adjustments may be required, such adjustments to not be unreasonably denied.

Either party shall have the right to ter , inate this MOU with or without cause u pon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party speci , ing the date of termination. If this MOU is so terminated, the parties shall be liable only for perform nee rendered or costs incurred, or which have been obligated, in accordance with che term of this MOU prior to the effective date of termination.

This MOU establishes a framework for oluntary cooperation between UVI, GSKN a.nd CFBC which is deemed by each to be in their respec ive best interests and which will result in desirable outcomes for each institution. Nothin herein shall be construed as establishing or imposing on any legal obligations on the other party, no is the execution of this MOU to be construct as an acceptance of any liability for any action contemplated by the MOU, either on the part of the respective institutions, or their employe s, agents and assigns.

Except as otherwise expressly set forth employment relationship shall be creat Agreement, and none of the parties shal whatsoever. Nothing in this MOU is int third party any rights or remedies by vi ue hereof.

This Agreement constitutes the entire a reement between the parties hereto, and all prior understandings or communications, wr ten or oral, with respect to the matters contained herein are merged herein.

UVI. GSKN a.nd CFBC each agreed that t ey, their designees and assigns are acting as independent contractors and not as an agent, partne  $\$ , employee or jo jnt venture party of the other party to this MOU.

Except as may othetwise be agreed in riting, each party shall bear their own expenses in connection with all matters contemplat d by this Agreement.

Each of the persons below executing th document warrants and represents to the others that he has the capacity and authority to enter nto this Agreement and that in doing so; he is not in viola tion of any other contract or oblig tion whatsoever.
