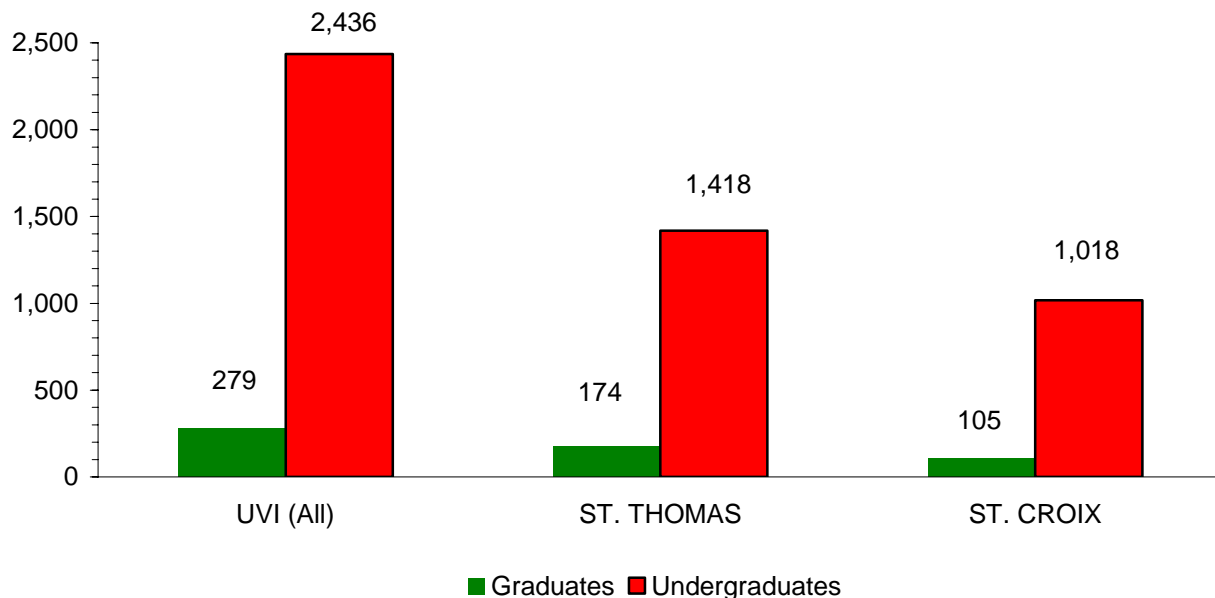


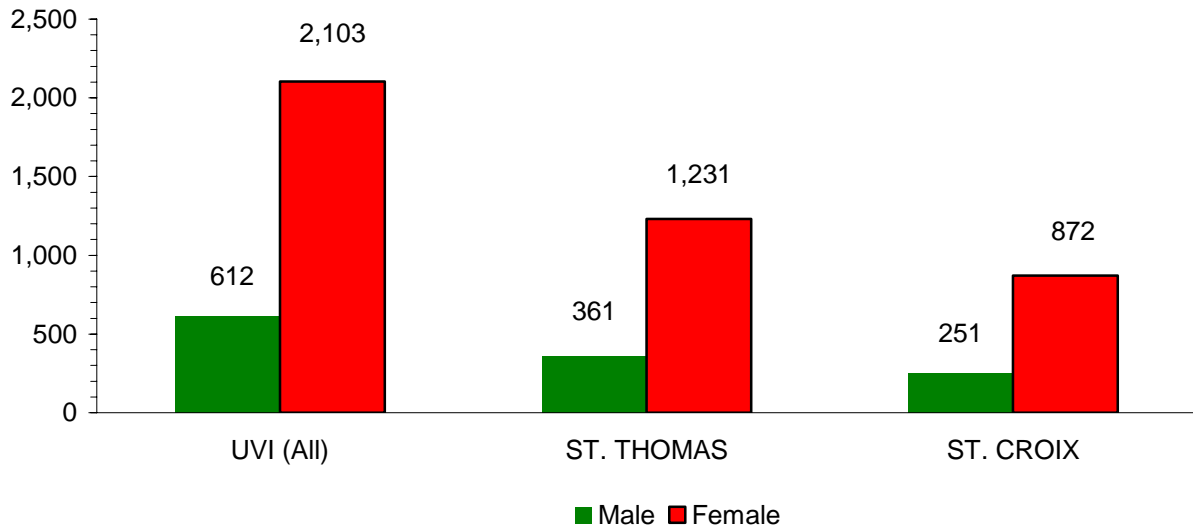

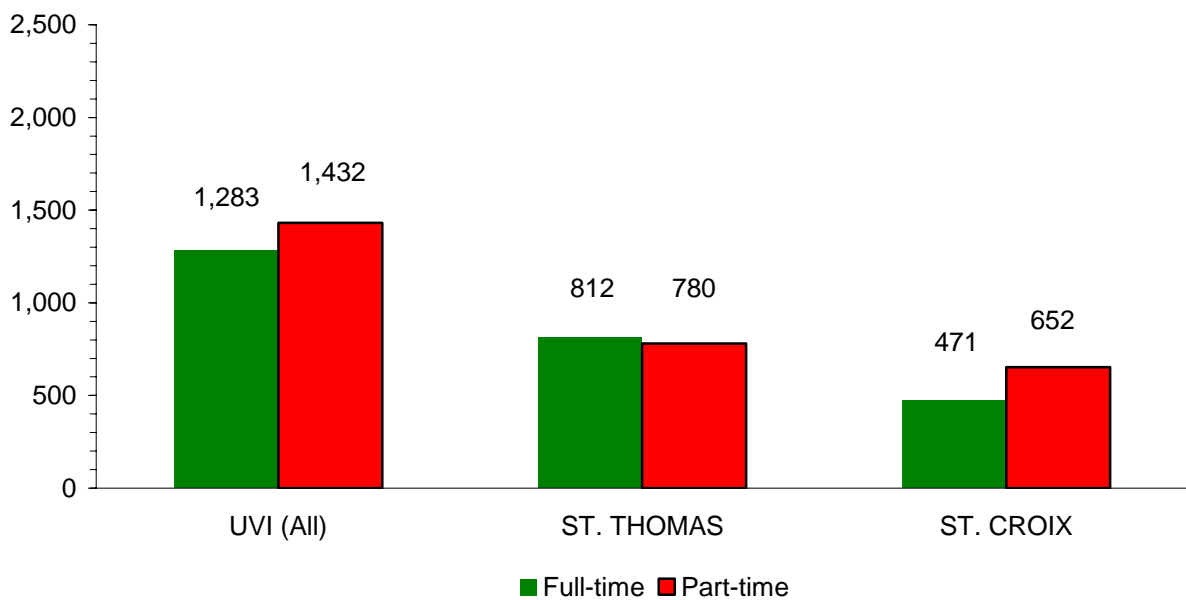
**Figure 1.1 Headcount Enrollment by Campus

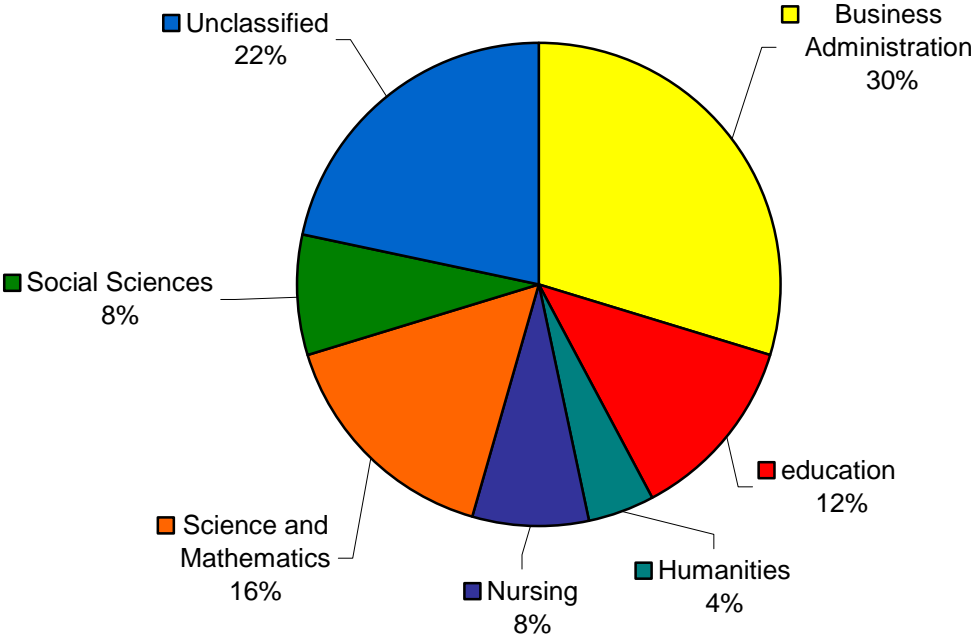

Fall 2003**

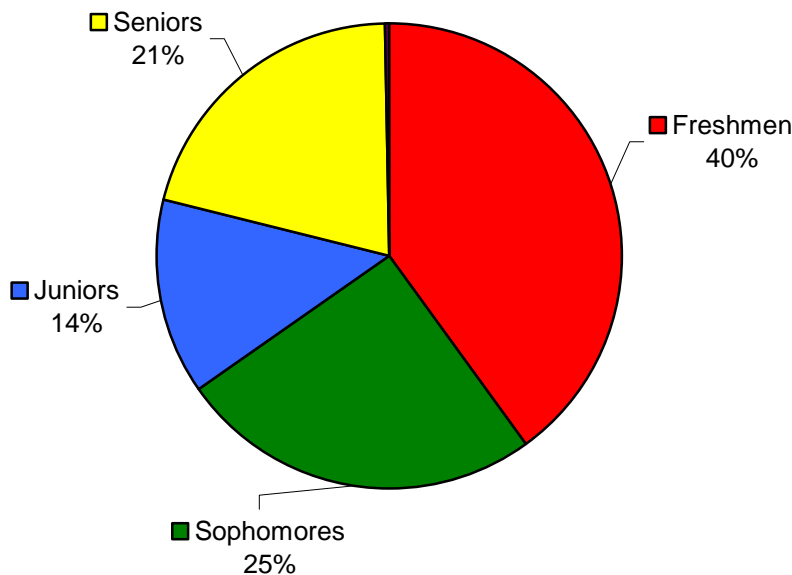
