

Figure 7.1a Full-Time Instructional Faculty By Campus Fall 2001-2005








Figure 7.2 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnic

Figure 7.5 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Rank Fall 2005


