SCHOLARSHIP/LOAN

A Virgin Islands Territorial Scholarship/Loan administered by the University of the Virgin Islands.

Awards subject to the availability of funds for the fiscal year 2024-2025.

Scholarships are intended for Virgin Islands residents pursuing graduate studies or cultural projects.


Eligibility Requirements:

- The applicant must: a) be pursuing full-time graduate studies or research; or
 b) be engaged in a Cultural Project which will be of substantial benefit to the people of the Virgin Islands.
- 2. The applicant must have been a resident of the United States Virgin Islands for at least ten (10) years, at least five (5) years of which must immediately precede the date of application.
- 3. The applicant must either have made a significant contribution to the Virgin Islands through government service or otherwise or must require financial support. Applicants seeking financial support must provide appropriate documentation justifying the need for financial assistance. Applicants seeking funding based on significant contribution to the people of the Virgin Islands must provide documentation of their contribution.
 - 4. All applicants approved for funding must execute a Contract of Commitment.
