

## **Junior Ocean Explorers Summer Program: Program Information**

- The maximum capacity for the Youth Ocean Explorers Summer Program is **20 students**. This is established for safety reasons; exceptions will not be made.
- At this time, on-campus housing is not provided for the Junior Ocean Explorers Summer Program.
- Students should wear comfortable clothing to the program each day. This should be shorts, provided JOE t-shirts, swim wear (no revealing swim wear for females), and comfortable shoes.
- Snorkel gear is provided; however, if your child has a pair that they own and prefer using, they are more than welcome to bring them.
- The Junior Ocean Explorers Summer Program takes place every year starting during the last week of June to avoid the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday and continues for one week. Please plan vacation time around these dates.
- There will be a mandatory orientation meeting for both parents and accepted students on the Friday before the program starts. Remaining supporting documents will be provided to parents and applicants to complete during the orientation meeting.
- Students are expected to be in attendance daily (**9:00AM - 4:30PM**) and any scheduled absences should be immediately brought to the attention of program coordinators.
- There is a one-time program fee of **\$100** which covers all program materials and lunches.
